Team Areas:	Teams will be allowed to camp in open areas at the playing sites. Teams <u>must</u> clean their camp area before leaving the facility.
Concessions:	Concessions will be available at all playing sites. No coolers, crock pots or outside food allowed at any of the sites.
Rules:	USAV rules will apply except: 12s teams will use the volley-lite balls and a short service line, 7'0" into the court and different liberos may be designated for each set.
Pool Play:	<p>3 team pools, Pool A and B, 14's Division- Each team in Pool A will play each of the 3 teams in pool B. Matches will best 2 of 3, first two sets to 25, 3rd set to 15 pts. No point caps on any of the sets and do not switch sides in third set. If two teams tie for 1st in either pool A or B, based on match won/loss record and set winning % , there will be a one set playoff to 15 pts between the two teams to decided which team advances to the Gold Division Playoff. The officiating team for the playoff match is the third team in the pool.</p> <p>3 team pools, if a team drops from a 4 team pool- If one team does not show up in a 4 team pool, the remaining 3 teams will play a match consisting of 3 games to 25, no point caps. Do not switch sides. Tiebreaker is match won/loss, head-to-head if two-way tie, set winning %, +/- points, coin toss.</p> <p>4 team pools- Best 2 of 3, first two sets to 25, 3rd set to 15 pts. No point caps on any of the sets and do not switch sides. Tiebreaker is match won/loss, head-to-head if two-way tie, set winning %, +/- points, coin toss.</p> <p>5 team pool (Pool C, 18's Red Division) – two sets to 25, capped at 27. If two teams tie for 2nd in this pool the tie breaker to decides which team advances to the Gold Division Playoff is: set winning %, head-to-head record, head-to-head points. If the two teams are still tied after head-head points there will be a one game playoff to 15 points officiated by either team A, B or E in that order and if not in the playoff match. A 3 way tie for first will be decided by set winning %, +/- points and then a coin toss.</p>

Tie Breaker:	Two way ties are decided based on head-to-head results. Three way ties are decided in the following order: set winning %; plus/minus points; coin toss.

Covid Protocol

The City of Duluth and the Superior School District have recently enacted mask mandates which we are obligated to follow for our tournaments.
